Dr. Chih is a Board Certified Emergency and Critical Care Specialist at Animal Medical Center of Seattle.

Born and raised in Queens, New York, Dr. Chih's first job was as a kennel/veterinary assistant. She received her DVM from the University of Missouri's College of Veterinary Medicine in 2011. During veterinary school, she saw the diversity of emergency/critical cases as personal challenges with her ultimate inspiration coming from her mother who taught her to have a strong work ethic with compassion for all beings.

Following graduation, Dr. Chih completed a small animal medicine and surgery rotating internship at Michigan Veterinary Specialists in 2012. She then completed an emergency/critical care specialty internship and a residency in emergency/critical care, both at Lakeshore Veterinary Specialists in Glendale, Wisconsin. Dr. Chih obtained board certification in emergency and critical care thereafter.
